### **PARADE POLICIES**

Please read carefully. Failure to follow any of these expectations may result in you losing all privileges of participating in **any** other non-athletic Homecoming activities including attending the pep rally, game, halftime activities and the dance. Sponsors, parents and all parade participants are responsible for knowing and following all of the expectations listed below.

1. No one rides on any float who has not been a major help in building the float or showcase. Therefore, in addition to parent permission, a signature from the group's sponsors is required..
2. Immediately obey all instructions/requests of school personnel during all parts of this activity.
3. Only candy may be **GENTLY** thrown underhand from the parade vehicles to the community as to not accidentally hit any of the students. Parade participants bring their own candy.
4. No littering the parade lot or along the parade route.
5. No swearing, offensive language or gestures in the parade lot, on parade vehicles or along the parade route.
6. No smoking, no drugs, no alcohol during any float preparation.
7. All body parts of people riding on a float or in a parade vehicle must remain INSIDE the vehicle's real or imaginary boundary plane.
8. No one will ride on the hood, top, tire covers or running boards of any vehicle.
9. No one gets off of or out of a parade vehicle at any time during the parade or along the parade route.
10. **Parade participants are REQUIRED to dress in PANTHER GEAR or in purple or white unless they are dressed in costumes related to the theme of their Homecoming float.**
11. **Community pride, POSITIVE school spirit and community relations are the goal of this parade. Participants are responsible for appropriate behavior and language. Failure to fully comply will result in the participant losing all Homecoming privileges.**
